

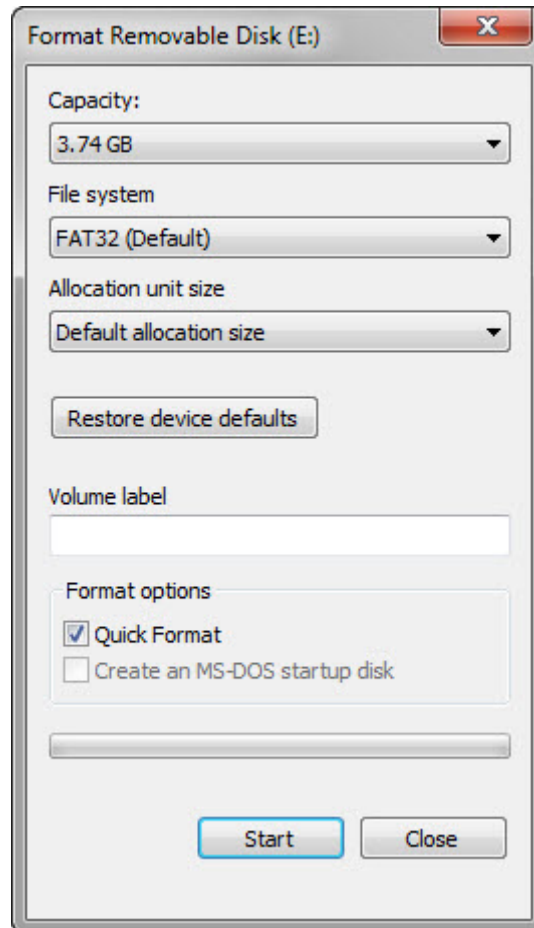
TACmV2 Memory Stick Issue

Some memory sticks are shipped with unusual formatting and TACmV2 cannot write to them

To check if the memory stick is working, follow the following procedure;

1. Plug in a fresh memory stick and leave it in TACmV2 for a few minutes
2. Remove memory stick and check that the stick now has 2 files on it;
 - a) EVENTLOG.TXT
 - b) LOG.TXT
3. You can open these files with a simple text editor (like Windows Notepad) and they will have entries
4. Check the EVENTLOG.TXT entries have today's current date and time; if not the time may need to be set (Refer Section 2a, also please ensure Battery insulator is removed)

If you have followed the above procedure and the memory stick has no files on it, it may be a formatting issue; using Windows please re-format the memory stick using the following settings;



You can also add a Volume label such as TACmV2log
